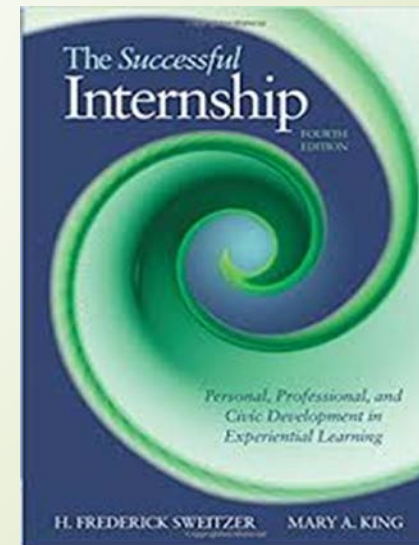

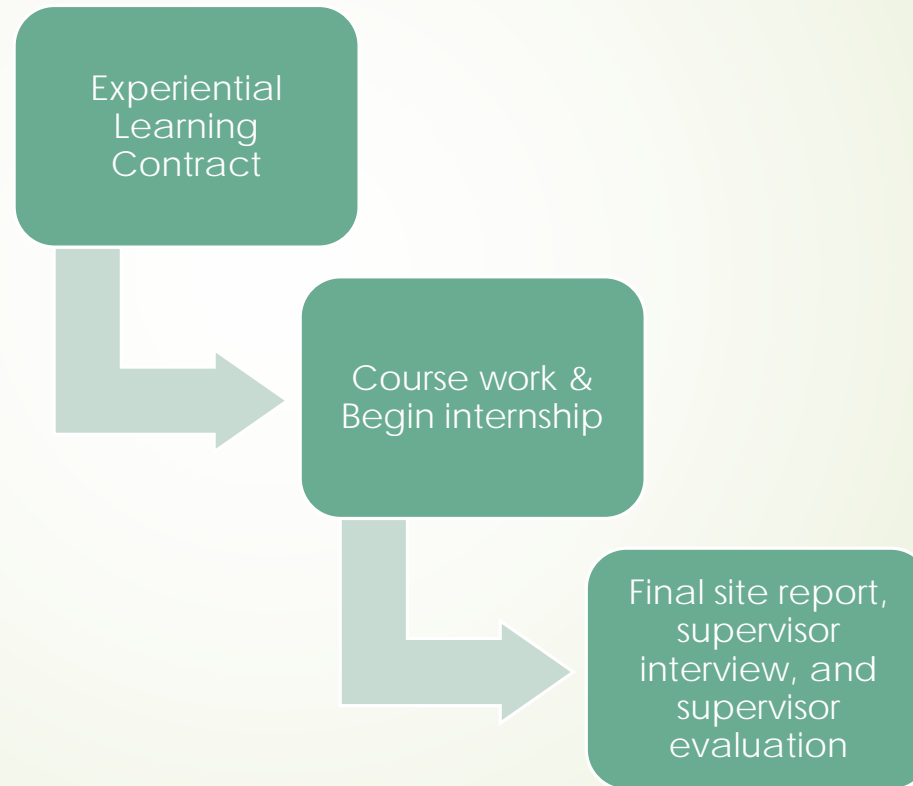
INTS 3398: Integrative Studies Internship

- Post survey: Agree, disagree, and strongly disagree

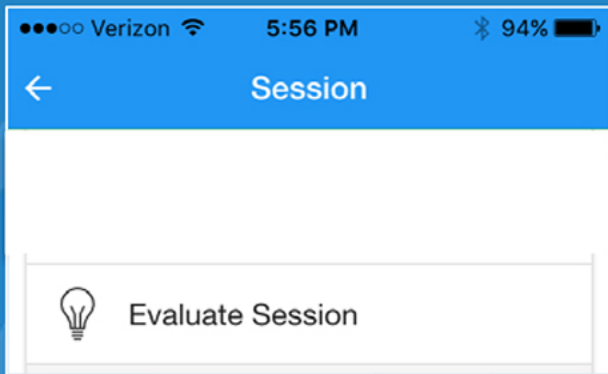
PRCA Instrument

- Q1: I am afraid to express myself at meetings
- Pre survey: Agree, neutral, disagree, and strongly disagree
- Post survey: Neutral, disagree, and strongly disagree
